



We are a group of diverse people, coming from different backgrounds, BUT we believe in one God.

Branston Methodist forms part of the Methodist Church of Southern Africa (MCSA). Methodism was born in the 18th century in England, started by John Wesley. He went to the people, travelling on horseback (covering about 6400 km a year) he preached about 40 000 sermons during his lifetime. His legacy was faith renewal groups "societies", that consisted of "classes" (small groups of about 12 people). These were Bible Study groups but more than that they cared for each other pastorally.

Wesley believed that EVERYBODY can be saved! that all can become more like Jesus as we follow Him.

Wesley also had a "Rule for Christian Living". Do all the good you can, by all the means you can, in all the ways you can, in all the places you can, at all the times you can, to all the people you can, as long as ever you can.

A shortened version of the Rule is: **Do no harm, do good, stay in love with God.**

BMC IS A TOOLBOX FOR YOUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY:

Methodist members are required to be baptized and confirmed. We only ask you to attend these meetings and take part in discussions – no exams or other "rights of passage"! We will then receive you into the congregation of your choice.
