## Q1 2024 CCS Outreach (1/2)

- ❖ On the 23 March 2024, the YWM Manyano BMC visited Imbali Enhle HIV and AIDS Foundation, a Care Centre in Dobsonville in Soweto as part of CCS Outreach for Quarter 1. This was a follow-up visit to the home from the initial visit that took place last year in May 2023.
- ❖ The home cares for the vulnerable people, young and old, abandoned by their families' and who are no longer able to care for them. The care center house 23 individuals aging from 5 months – 89 years old.
- ❖ Our main objective was to return to the home to provide the most essential needs for the home which included the the installation of curtain rails and curtains; the bedding, blankets, groceries and clothes for the abandoned 3-year-old girl recently adopted by the home.

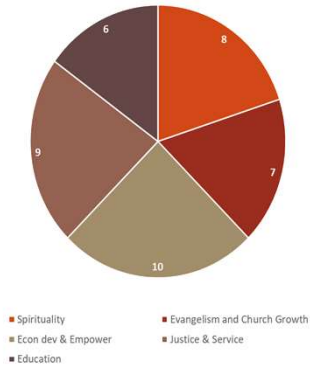

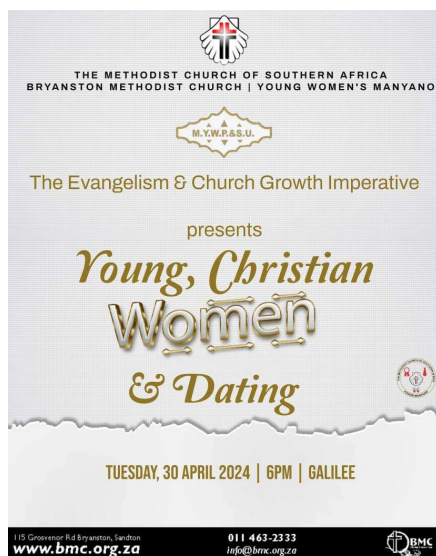




## Evangelism & Church growth Imperative

## Q3 2024 Junior Manyano Report (1/2)

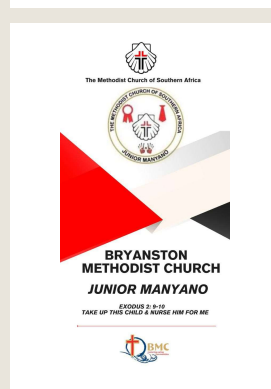
- ❖ Sis Zikhona Mjali (OT) has volunteered to assist with our JM
