<u>Youth & Young Adults</u> 2024 ASM Report

Friday Night Youth

- Friday Night Youth kicked off in January with the Alpha Youth course. We learnt a lot on the Christian foundations and fellowshipped together.
- Term 3 focused on building Godly relationships while journeying through the teaching series "Boy Meets Girl" by Louie Giglio. The series challenged the youth to find their value in God first before anything else, recognise and work through some of the baggage we as people take into relationships, and trusting and actively waiting on God for the relationships He has in store for us.
- Term 4 we are focusing on the Armour of God, seeing how we can apply it to our daily life.
- Attendance averaged at 20–24 teens per session, seeing a significant drop during the exam seasons.

Sunday Teen Church

- Teen Church runs every Sunday during the public-school terms. The online lessons are uploaded on the BMC YouTube channel all year round, including during school holidays. The link is sent out on the BMC broadcast groups and the Youth WhatsApp group.
- Our lessons are on the same themes as the church.

- Our attendance averages at 20-30 weekly for each service, which has been a huge increase from last year. As expected, we do see a drop in attendance during the exam seasons.
- We have seen an increase in our leadership this year with 8 leaders (including teens) who assist in the 9am and 11am teen church.

- The classes ran in-person each Sunday afternoon except during school holidays and June exams. We had a few guest speakers at some of the sessions.
