Children's Church & Youth Online

Our online ministry continues to be an important part of our outreach, mirroring the lessons we teach in person. This allows children who cannot attend in person to stay connected and engaged with our teachings.

Throughout the year, our interns have supported the online content beautifully—this past term they even appeared on-screen and did an exceptional job.

We were blessed to receive two new laptops for registration—an incredible gift from an anonymous donor. This made registration faster and more efficient, and we were deeply grateful for this generosity. Sadly, these laptops were stolen during the recent robbery.

Teaching Series

We continue to follow the broader church teaching calendar, adapting lessons for our different age groups. When needed, we use alternative series from either the Old or New Testament to ensure age-appropriate teaching.

- Term 1: *Epiphany to Transfiguration* well received and effective.
- Term 2: Followed the main church series, again with positive engagement.
- Term 3: Focused on *Old Testament stories and characters*. Volunteers were encouraged to choose and lead sessions on their favourite stories, such as *Elijah and the Widow (1 Kings)*. This approach empowered our leaders and enriched our teaching variety.
- Term 4: Skipped ahead to *Advent*. We decided this would be beneficial as children are usually on holiday during Advent, allowing them to now learn about the season before it begins.

We were also privileged to welcome two visiting missionaries, whose time with the children was engaging, inspiring, and full of joy.

During Term 4, our ministers have begun visiting the children's groups, a wonderful initiative helping the children get to know their Ministers and allowing the ministers to experience the children in their normal Sunday setting.

Worship

Worship remains a vital part of our ministry. Every session—both online and in person—begins with prayer and thanksgiving.

We are eagerly awaiting the completion of vernacular worship videos recorded by our worship team. These will add wonderful diversity to our worship times once the final editing is complete.

Volunteers

Our volunteer drive remains open throughout the year, and we are thrilled by the continued growth in interest.

- February: 20 volunteers completed training and police clearance.
- May: An additional 5 volunteers were cleared.
- Ongoing: Further sessions planned for October/November if needed.

Junior Youth (Grades 4-7)

Junior Youth continues to grow from strength to strength.

- Term 1: Restarted on 17 January, meeting every second week and averaging 10 children.
- Term 2: Continued from 9 May with similar attendance.
- Term 3: Expanded to weekly meetings from 25 August, averaging 12–15 children.
- Term 4: We now meet an hour earlier to accommodate Nativity play rehearsals. All the children involved are invited to join Junior Youth afterward, and attendance has grown to around 22 children.

Each session begins with a devotion led by a different leader, followed by games, crafts, or activities linked to the theme. Topics have included *The Fruit of the Spirit, Prayer, Kindness*, and *Time with God*.

Highlights so far:

- Parent Movie Night (*Mufasa*): Attended by 91 people.
- RollEgoli Outing: 30 children enjoyed a fun day out.
- Ice-Skating Fundraiser (27 April): Over 100 participants hugely successful!
- Monte Movies Outing: 15 children and several parents enjoyed a relaxed evening together.
- Neon Dance Party: Our joint youth event was a huge success, with nearly 80 children attending —
 a night of luminous fun and fellowship!

- Ice-Skating Fundraiser (April): Over 100 skaters participated, making it a successful family and fundraising event.
- Holiday Club (30 June–4 July):
 What an incredible week! Around 70 children attended daily, supported by 30 teen and young adult leaders.
 - o We were joined by children from the Johannesburg Children's Home.
 - Meals, finances, and prayers from members and small groups made the week possible.
 - o Immense gratitude to our leaders, staff, and parents who made it all happen!

Drives & Outreach

We are committed to cultivating generosity and compassion in our children and families.

- Easter Drive: Supported the Gerald Fitzpatrick Nursing Home, delivering 59 Care parcels through the help of the congregation and young adults.
- Christmas Drive (Upcoming): Begun earlier this year. We are supporting one home; Little Eden located in Edenvale. We are collecting for 100 residences.
