LANSERIA A PLACE OF WORSHIP - Annual Report.

Greetings to the BMC Leadership, in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, Amen.

1. Background:

Lanseria a Place of Worship is in Malatjie an Informal Settlement in Lanseria, which is ten (10) minutes away from the privately owned (Public Investment Corporation, The Pan African Infrastructure Development Fund and Nozala Investment Holdings) Lanseria International Airport. Smart City Plans are underway which will affect our current location.

2. Highlights:

It is indeed by God's Grace that the Lanseria congregation continues to grow spiritually, This growth can only be attributed to The Triune God *Modimo Ntate! Modimo Mora! Modimo Moya Ohalalelang!* It is evident with the growing number of our Sunday School, Junior Manyano, Wesley Guild, Young Women's Manyano, YMG, Women's Manyano and members of the Church Choir and their ability to write the weekly reports to the Ministers. During Easter weekend we experienced the robing one of our WM and YMG members and on the 8th November 2025 two (2) YWM and eight (8) JM members were also robed as well.

4. Mission Pillars:

4.1. SPIRITUALITY:

- We had our closing Service on the 8th December 2024 with a Holy Communion service that was led by Rev Makgamathe and were ushered-in and welcomed into 2025 with a Holy Communion Service that was led by Rev Mcinga on the 12th January 2025.
- On the 19th January 2025, the Steward **Mme Molefe** was given the Lanseria Candle to continuously pray for the Congregation and the MCSA leadership.

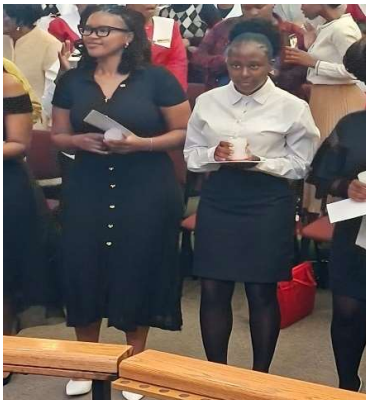

4.2. EVANGELISM AND CHURCH GROWTH:

- On Palm Sunday the 13th of April 2025, the BMC YMG led a Street Revival in Malatjie which started with a service @ 07h30am and we carried Palm branches throughout our walk around the area to remind the Community of Inkonzo Yamahlamvu, Jesus' grand entrance in Jerusalem.
- We were pleased to be joined by the Central District Lay Leader Bro Lusi Badi, BMC Women's Manyano, YWM and Wesley Guilders were also part of the entourage.

- On the 29th January 2025, Mme Malaka lost her Husband through ill-health. Prayers were held at the Malaka residence by the WM, YWM and the community, funeral was on the 8th February 2025 in Erasmia Pretoria and our Members were present.
- We appreciated the donation of groceries together with clothes from the BMC Sunday Manyano and the YWM to the Xhobi Children.
- Groceries and School shoes from the Circuit were donated to our Children.
- We have requested the Joseph Storehouse to pack the food separately for the Xobi Children to avoid them from having to collect the food themselves.
- On the 15th June 2025, we had a prayer service where we prayed for the High Unemployment in our community, GBV&F Victims and the Eastern & KZN Flood Victims.

4.4. HUMAN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & EMPOWERMENT:

- We were surprised by the BMC Wesley Guilders on Mother's Day, the 11th May 2025 to do an outreach, they served us with a very healthy and delicious warm meals.
